

# OUTBACK BBQ STANDS



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Designed for camping and 4wd enthusiasts who have a Weber Q. The stand stores under the BBQ when not in use and only takes up 5mm of space under the Weber.

When set up it provides a sturdy platform for the BBQ to sit on with hooks for hand tools, hotplates and trivets.

It has a handy side table and adjustable legs to level the stand on uneven ground.

As an optional extra there is a chopping board and a wash tub so the stand becomes a totally multifunctional tool for making your meal, from preparation, and cooking to washing up.

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## Outback BBQ stands - How it all started.....

In 2011 my wife and i decided to take 3 months off work and head North with the family . We set the date - July 1<sup>st</sup> 2012 which gave us plenty of time to get organised. Some friends thought it would be great too, and decided to join us.

As it is with all good mates, we enjoyed getting together to discuss and prepare our vehicles for the road trip. This included , what and how we were going to cook.

The decision of how we were going to cook was pretty easy, Weber Q's of course.. My mate wanted to build a box for his weber so that he could both store it and use the box as a stand. I had a bit of a think about this and being pretty handy with steel and a Mig welder suggested that we could do better than that. I came up with the idea of a metal frame that the weber could sit on while in transit and then attach 4 legs to the stand to get it to a comfortable cooking height when ready to use. I attached some hooks for the tools and hotplates to hang and a side table to put your food on. I instantly saw how handy this stand was going to become and the small amount of storage room that it would take up as it stored away under the BBQ lifting it by a mere 5mm.

Well it finally came time for us to head off on our trip, by night 2 we were up at Uluru in the NT and setting up camp for the night in the caravan park. No sooner had we pulled our Weber BBQ's out and set them up on the stand, we had people coming over to ask about them. This confirmed for me that not only did i think it was a great idea, but so did everyone else.

After getting back to Adelaide I let the idea of the BBQ stands go for about a year and one day got up and said to myself, I need to do something with these stands. I headed out to my workshop and started to make a more refined version of the stand, with telescopic legs and a table that all folded up into the stand and sat under the Weber. The next step was a patent to protect this idea and finally get the product into production.

The response to the design has been very exciting as too have been the amount of people that have already purchased one of these stands. , before they were even finished.

We have now added to what these stands can be used for by adding in a chopping board and a washing up tub as optional extras, so now it really is a multifunction stand that all campers should have.





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## Set up instructions.

Step 1 take out the frame and turn it upside down

Step 2 take all 4 legs and extend them until the spring clip locks into the extended position.

Step 3 - back off all M6 wing bolts so that the legs can be inserted all the way into the leg sockets and tighten the wing bolts.

Step 4 turn the stand the right side up and sit on the ground. If the stand is uneven or wobbles on the ground loosen off one of the M6 wing bolts on the leg that isn't making contact with the ground and drop it down a little bit until it is firm against the ground then re tighten the wing bolt on that leg.

Step 5 sit the side table on the stand lining up the notches with the vertical edge on either the left or right hand side

Step 6. Lift the Weber into position and sit on top of stand.

.\*\*\*WARNING WHEN USING THE SIDE TABLE, DON'T PUT EXCESIVE WEIGHT ON IT THIS COULD CAUSE THE STAND TO TIP OVER RESULTING IN INJURY\*\*\*\*

## Pack up instructions.

Step 1 remove the table

Step 2 turn stand upside down and remove all 4 legs.

Step 3 press round spring button in on legs and slide inner pole in until it is the internal length of the stand

Step 4 turn stand the right side up, and sit table in the stand upside down

Step 5 sit all 4 legs in between the table supports

Step 6 sit Weber on top of stand and store away.
